### La MANCHE project overall objective

To promote the modernisation of Partner Countries' higher education systems by:

- building governance and management capacities at Partner Countries HEIs,
- empowering students to become more actively involved in decision making at HEIs and
- initiating sustainable dialogue on higher education institutional reforms among relevant interest groups.

- advocates for gender equality in higher education.
