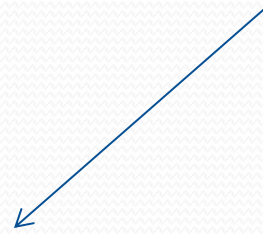
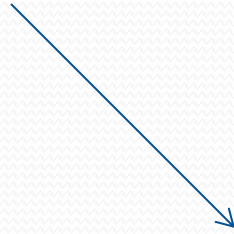
Introduction
